

Clean & Comfy Booster Seat

015611 / BO069 User Guide

Age: 6 months to 4 years. Maximum weight: 20 kg. Adult assembly required.

⚠ WARNING:

- · Prevent serious injury or death from sliding out, falls, or tipping over.
- **ALWAYS** secure child in the restraint until child is able to get in and out of the booster seat without help (about 2-1/2 years old). The tray, if supplied, is not designed to hold the child in the chair.
- **NEVER** leave child unattended.
- **NEVER** allow a child to push away from table.
- **ALWAYS** fasten seat and back straps securely to adult chair.
- **ALWAYS** check security of fit to adult chair before each use.
- · This booster seat is only to be used with standard kitchen or dining room chairs. **NEVER** use this product as a car seat or bath seat, on a tabletop, stool, swivel chair, or any other seating surface where the straps cannot secure it properly.
- Prevent serious injury or death. **NEVER** use in motor vehicles.
- **ALWAYS** ensure that all chair protector pads are located completely on the adult chair surface.
- Discontinue use if damaged, broken or if parts are missing.

CAUTION:

- Keep small parts away from children during assembly.
- Remove all contents from packaging and discard box and/or poly bags.
- · Lay out and identify all parts.
- Before Assembly: Wipe down trays with a soft cloth and warm soapy water








To Assemble

Preassembled Parts **G D G H**:

Three protector pads (Figure 1a) and child waist restraint (Figure 1b) will come preassembled to base and seat, respectively.







To Assemble (continued)

2 Attach Seat 😉 🗗 :

Place seat face-down on flat surface with hooks and snaps facing upward (Figure 2a). Align base and seat as shown (Figure 2b). Turn seat so that underside of the base faces towards you. Insert hooks on the seat into the corresponding slots on the base (Figure 2c). Ensure hooks are inserted correctly; locking tabs should slide beneath them (Figure 2d).










3 Secure Seat 3 6:

Place hands on seat base as seen below and firmly push base until it is fully engaged with seat (**Figure 3a**). After seat clicks into place, ensure that hooks and snaps are locked and secure as seen below (**Figure 3b**).

Note: If seat is not secure, use force to push base onto seat to ensure proper attachment.






4 Attach Chair Straps (2 sets) • • •:


Locate chair straps. Snap buckles together (Figure 4a).

With one set of straps, insert folded ends into two openings on back of the base (Figure 4b).

With second set of straps, insert folded ends into two openings on either side of the base (Figure 4c).

Pull each strap to ensure strap is secure.






To Use

1 Protect Adult Chair **G**:

Place chair topper on adult seat (Figure 1a).

Place seat on chair, over chair topper (Figure 1b).







2 Chair Straps **0**:

Pass the bottom chair strap completely under base of chair and secure buckle (Figure 2a). Tighten chair strap for security.

Pass rear chair strap around back of chair and secure buckle (**Figure 2b**). Tighten chair strap for security.





♠ WARNING:

- ALWAYS use both sets of chair straps to completely secure booster to the chair.
- If chair is cushioned and cushion cannot be removed, **BE CERTAIN** that the bottom chair strap is fastened snugly after putting child in seat.
- Make sure all pieces are assembled correctly. Test for proper assembly before placing child in seat.
- **ALWAYS** secure child in booster seat using restraint straps.
- ALWAYS ensure that all chair protector pads are located completely on the adult chair surface.

3 Restraint System **D**:

Position your child in booster seat. Place restraint straps between legs and buckle into position (Figure 3a). Adjust restraint straps for proper fit (Figure 3b).





4 Attach Tray 🗛 🕒 🛈:


Slide tray into slots on either side of seat until it clicks into place. Pull on tray to ensure that it is completely engaged (Figure 4a).

Insert tray: Align on main tray for use.

To remove tray: Depress tray releases on both sides of tray and pull away from seat **(Figure 4b)**.

⚠ WARNING:

The tray is not a restraint device. **ALWAYS** use restraint straps to secure child to booster seat.





To Clean

Booster and Tray:

Clean before first use and after each use. Wipe with soft cloth and warm soapy water. Use only mild non-abrasive soap. Both trays are dishwasher safe (top rack only).
